Central Committee

CCSR1: All conventions and Central Committee Meeting attendance to be released to the precincts.
Adopted May 30, 2009

CCSR2: To move the previous question you must be recognized by the chair.
Adopted November 9, 2013

Executive Committee

ECSR1: Formal Complaints Procedures
Adopted 5/21/09

Discussion on Procedure: Formal Complaints

- **Item 1:** What establishes a Formal Complaint?
Written complaint delivered to Party Chair, Vice Chair and filed with Secretary.

- **Item 2:** What is the process?

Chair:

- 1) Contact maker of complaint and seek a remedy to resolve issue.
- 2) Forward complaint to all involved and forward to Executive Committee.

Executive Committee:

- 1) Meet to screen complaint to determine if there is a basis.
- 2) If basis, move to a hearing or dismiss complaint.

- **Item 3:** Where are Formal Complaints to be heard?
 - 1) Both committees have that power.

ECSR2: Videotaping of Executive Committee Meetings is prohibited.
Adopted May 20, 2010

ECSR3: Executive Committee to vote by raised hand on all Motions of consequence with tallied count recorded in minutes.
