Senate Caucus Procedures

Ballots for SCC elections will be in delegate convention packet. The Elections Committee will accept one ballot from each credentialed delegate who provides a valid senate district credential for that election prior to depositing the ballot in the ballot box. The Elections Committee will proceed to the Elections Room under direction of Elections Chair. Poll watchers may proceed to the elections room to observe the counting of ballots. Only members of the Convention Committee may cast early ballots.

The caucus chair may turn the remainder of the time to the State Senator and House District Representative(s) to report to the county delegates.

Election results will be announced in the Convention Hall.
